

LAST TIME OUT

NEWQUAY 0 PENZANCE 1

A run of 23 consecutive competitive defeats was finally terminated as the Magpies opened their season's account with hard-fought win at Mount Wise on Wednesday night. In recent years the vicinity has proved to be a happy hunting ground. Penzance's last points were accrued from a 4-3 success back in October across town at Godolphin Atlantic, who were also beaten 3-2 in November 2020. So the last three wins on the road have all been in Newquay.

The Penzance management made two changes to the side defeated by Godolphin four days earlier, Haidar Fadli reverting to the bench to accommodate Kameron Collins's return from cricket commitments, and

summer signing Alex Ralph replacing Obinna Abuka up front.

Whilst being limited to one clear chance of his own, which the Newquay defence somehow scrambled clear just before the break, Ralph - a prolific Combination scorer in recent seasons with Rosudgeon and Pendeen Rovers – injected a physicality that has been missing from Penzance's attack. Though the hosts generally dominated the opening half, hitting the bar and stretching Mikey Flores to two excellent saves, the Magpies showed enough to hint a shock may be on the cards, particularly with two efforts from Darryl Richards that only just missed the target.

In drizzly conditions, the second period followed a similar pattern with the Peppermints on top but showing little sign of making a breakthrough. This continued until Penzance made a double change midway through the half. Returning from a three game absence, Cam McCabe replaced Rocco Hill in midfield whilst Rolandos Samnauskas relieved Ralph up front. Within five minutes, the move had paid as the striker, on his return from suspension, flustered the Newquay defence into a poor clearance. Kizzy Snowden pounced on the loose ball, carried it forward and cracked a low right foot shot from the edge of the area into the far corner of Harry Ashton's net.

The visitors managed the remaining sixteen minutes plus stoppage time well, and almost doubled the lead when Samnauskas saw a shot deflected wide. Though Newquay did finally force the ball home right at the death, an offside flag intervened to confirm the most welcome of victories for Penzance.

MATCH REPORT

PENZANCE 0 GODOLPHIN ATLANTIC 1

The Magpies were never able to recover from an early concession, and slipped to a third home defeat inside ten days as Godolphin Atlantic continued an impressive start to the season under manager Harry Pope.

Missing eight players, including influential performers such as Tyler Tonkin, Kevin Lawrence, Cam McCabe, Jacob Trudgeon and Robertas Samnauskas, Penzance found themselves under the cosh in the first half hour against an in-form team that has racked up eleven goals in its opening two games. Eli Evans signalled early intent, cutting in from the right to fire just over before "the G" deservedly took the lead on the quarter hour mark. The home defence was slow to react to a Matt Walker free-kick and Matt Sanders muscled his way into the perfect position to head home at the far post.

A much improved conclusion to the half for Penzance saw Darryl Richards fire straight at keeper Adam Robathan after being released by Rocco Hill. A key moment immediately followed when Hill was tripped, to the eyes of most observers, just inside the box. Jonothan Green, however, awarded a free-kick and teenager Tyler Dayus saw his blasted effort charged down.

Two excellent chances followed at the start of the second period. Against his former club, Kizzy Snowden made a surging run forward before picking out Haidar Fadli's intelligent run with an accurate chip. Sadly the youngster's glancing header just missed its target. Dayus, who had another hugely impressive game, then located Silas Sullivan from a free-kick, but the captain-for-the-day was unable make a clean connection and Rothathan saved easily.

Thereafter, frustration started to increase and the chances dried up as Godolphin eased their way to a third win in four games. "It is difficult at the moment, obviously we are not getting results," said joint manager John MacCallum afterwards. "It's a game we've competed well in - we don't deserve defeat, but that is what we are getting. One moment, a free header from a set-piece, has cost us. We haven't been outplayed in any of the games we've had this season, so that is positive. Rome wasn't built in a day – results will come, for sure."
